Establishment of a Representative Office in New Caledonia

Sumitomo Metal Mining Co., Ltd. ("SMM", Headquarters: Minato-ku, Tokyo President

and Representative Director: Nobumasa Kemori) has decided to open a representative

office in Nouméa, the capital of French-governed New Caledonia.

SMM imports roughly half of the nickel ore that forms the raw material for its

ferro-nickel business from New Caledonia. In the midst of intense global competition for

resources, New Caledonia is becoming an increasingly important area for SMM's

ferro-nickel business, and SMM plans to continue its procurement of a stable supply of

nickel ore from this area.

SMM is also participating in the Goro Nickel Project that is underway in this area.

Through establishing a representative office in Nouméa, SMM intends to enhance its

information gathering and project support structure in this area.
