Sumitomo Metal Mining Co., Ltd. (TSE: 5713) has been recognized by CDP in the highest-rated Climate A List for two consecutive years and in the second highest-rated Water A- score for its leadership in corporate performance and disclosure transparency.



CDP is a global non-profit that runs the world's environmental disclosure system. More than 24,800 companies - representing two thirds of the global market capitalization - and over 1,000 cities, states, and regions disclosed data through CDP in 2024.

Based on the Sumitomo Metal Mining Group's roadmap for achieving carbon neutrality by 2050, the Group aims to reduce absolute greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions and emissions intensity through operational improvements and technological innovation, as well as to expand its business through the development of products that contribute to a low-carbon society, such as battery materials and near-infrared absorbing materials.

Furthermore, the Group promotes water-related initiatives based on its Water Policy, such as reduction of water withdrawal and discharge amounts by promoting the use of recycled and reused water, and promotion of effective use of water by understanding water balance and optimizing the amounts used.

The Group is striving to actively engage in climate change and water initiatives, and to disclose information, with aim of realizing a sustainable society.
