Notice regarding Unauthorized Access to the IT system of a Philippine Subsidiary

Sumitomo Metal Mining Co., Ltd. (TSE: 5713) (“Sumitomo Metal Mining” or the “Company”) announces that certain servers of Coral Bay Nickel Corporation (“CBNC”), a Sumitomo Metal Mining’s nickel smelting subsidiary in the Philippines (Head Office: Palawan Province, Republic of the Philippines), have been affected by a ransomware incident resulting from unauthorized access by a third party. Please refer below for the circumstances and the impacts identified to date.

The Company will promptly disclose any new information as it becomes available.

Sumitomo Metal Mining sincerely apologizes for the concern this may cause to its business partners and all stakeholders.

[Background]

On Thursday, April 2, Sumitomo Metal Mining detected that two CBNC servers had been encrypted. As the incident was presumed to have been caused by a ransomware infection resulting from unauthorized access by a third party, the Company immediately isolated the affected servers.

The Company is currently working, with the support of external specialists, to investigate the scope of impact and to restore the affected systems.

[Impacts Identified to Date]

- **Production**
There has been no impact on the control systems of CBNC’s production plant, and operations are continuing.
In addition, there has been no impact on production activities at the Company’s group’s other mines, smelters, refineries, and plants.
- **Communications**
Sumitomo Metal Mining has disconnected the networks at CBNC, as well as at Sumitomo Metal Mining Philippine Holdings Corporation and Taganito HPAL Nickel Corporation, which share part of the communications network with CBNC.
There has been no impact on any of the Group’s sites located outside the Philippines.
- **Financial results and announcement**
At this time, Sumitomo Metal Mining regards the impact on its consolidated financial results for the fiscal year ended March 2026 as likely to be limited; however, the Company is currently conducting a detailed assessment of the impact, including any potential impact on the financial announcement.
